Informational Letter for Top Flight Golf Club Members

The Officers of Top Flight Golf Club would like to welcome you to Top Flight. Top Flight Golf Club is an Associate Club of the NCGA. All Top Flight Golf Club members must also be NCGA members.

We think this is going to be another exciting year for our new and returning members. **This is your club.** Your participation and support are vital to have success. Top Flight Golf Club is happy to accept new members throughout the year. If you know someone who would like to join Top Flight, please direct them to our website, <u>www.topflightgolfclub.net</u>. Our website is improving each year. All club members will need to become familiar with the website and begin using it as it is your resource for all club information. Information for tournaments, results, schedules, registration for membership, By-Laws & Operating Procedures are on the site.

If we encounter bad weather on or before a tournament day, you will receive an email from the Tournament Director.

For Your Information:

At no additional cost, all Top Flight Members are included in the Hole-In-One fund. Details are in the Operating Procedures.

For tournaments with fifty or more players, the club will pay, 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for three flights, and two closest to the pin contests. For tournaments with less than fifty players, the club will pay 1st and 2nd places for two or three flights and two closest to the pin contests.

Credits for Tournament Fees:

If you are a no show on the day of the tournament or you canceled after the deadline, you have paid for the tournament and the course does not charge the club, you will receive a credit to be used for a future tournament. That's usually the case but not always, so be aware of this policy. If you are a no show or canceled after the deadline and the club is charged for your spot and you haven't paid your entry fees, you will need to reimburse Top Flight Golf Club.

Club Championship Format:

Members must play five tournaments and the one designated Club Championship Tournament, which will be in October this year, weather permitting. The average of each Player's five best scores during the year will make up half of the Club Championship score. The other half of the Club Championship score will come from the one designated Club Championship Tournament.

Ready Golf:

We don't want anyone to feel rushed on the course, but if you fall behind, **please play ready golf**. The foursomes behind you, the course and the club will applaud your efforts to keep up with the foursome in front of you.

Tournament Costs:

The club adds \$10 to the amount the course charges for each tournament. The additional \$10 is split into the following: \$3 goes to the Tournament Prize fund, \$1 goes to the Closest to the Pin Contests, \$6 goes into the Club's General Fund, which includes the Hole-In-One Fund and funds most of the raffle prizes for the end of the year awards banquet. Example: The course charges \$60 per player and we add \$10 for a total of \$70 per player.

Payments:

It is a Top Flight G. C. requirement to pay the Tournament Entry Fee at least 10 days prior to the Tournament. If these Fees are not received by then, you may be put on a Waiting List.

If you are a Chase customer, you can pay online by using Chase Quick Pay. The recipient is: Top Flight Golf Club. The Club email address you need to enter is: <u>treasurer@topflightgolfclub.net</u>

You can pay by check by mailing your check to Dan McCann, Top Flight G. C. Treasurer. Dan's address is on our website. <u>Please make your check out to Top Flight Golf Club.</u> There will be a \$25 returned check fee if your check is not honored. This is a bank charge, not a club charge.

You can use you own Bank's Bill Pay Option.

Local Club Rule:

We play Winter Rules year round. A 6 inch bump, no closer to the pin, is only allowed on fairways and in the rough throughout the course. You cannot bump balls in Bunkers or Penalty Areas. It is important that we always keep in mind the integrity of the Game of Golf and play within the Rules of Golf. All members should be playing equally under the same Rules.
