Dear Church Family,

What is your favorite thing about the fall? I love the cooler nights, the colorful leaves, the fresh apples, and everyone's gardens producing the final crop of produce. I love the rhythm of the seasons – that rhythm is so clear and definitive here in New England where many of us live.

In the passage above, God has just finished a great and terrible flood, judgement upon all the evil in the world. Then Noah, in gratitude to God for delivering his family (and probably in his grateful relief for finally getting off of that ark!), builds an altar to worship God. Then God gives a promise. The promise is as much about God's control over the rhythms of the earth as it is about His provision for all that is needed for our lives – the food to sustain us.

Harvest – it is a wonderful time of year. Let me ask you: Who provides the seed? Who provides the rain? Who provides the light from the sun? God does.

Noah had such a desire to thank God that he presented God with a special offering. And God noticed and responded in love to Noah.

What do you and I have to offer God, as a sign of our gratitude? We no longer offer sacrifices of animals. Yet we can give something, can't we? Something which shows God our gratitude? Something which expresses to God how thankful we are to Him for His provision?

What will YOU present to God as YOUR offering to show Him your gratitude?
