My name is Ms. Morgan. I have been in the childcare field since 2015 and teach this age during the summer.

I enjoy working with kids because they make me laugh. 😊

The children this age are so special because they are beginning to form relationships and develop 'Big Kids' skills. I love seeing the excitement and curiosity that comes with learning at this age.

We do music, art, and freeplay daily as well as lots of outside time – sometimes even trips to the park next door.

We work on learning skills for 4 and 5K readiness using our fine motor skills by utilizing new tools. Math skills are learned by practicing counting and number recognition work. The children love learning about the world around them as they begin to understand how things work.

We usually begin our day by doing 'group'. This consists of calendar practice, singing songs, weather review, and learning about ourselves. We finish off group by doing reading a story or two. We then go on to music and art.

We do try to get outside daily weather permitting. I also ask that an extra set of weather appropriate clothes be brought in in case of accidents or something spilling on your child during snack or lunch. It's always nice to have a clean, dry set of clothing to change into! During the warmer weather I ask you to bring a swimsuit, beach towel, and water bottles.

I encourage children to always treat each other with kindness.

(I uphold an anti-bullying stance and try to have children work out problems on their own with supervision. We try to come up with ideas as to how to avoid these conflicts in the future. It is amazing how well with a little help the children can 'fix' things amongst themselves.)
