



Welcome to the 2 1/2 - 3 year old room.

My name is Ms. Kim. I have been in the childcare field since 1997. I enjoy reading, coloring, and snuggling my kids.

The children this age are learning how to go potty, dress themselves, and be kind and caring to each other. We learn about our emotions and how to deal with them.

We do free-play (because that's how we learn) as well as going outside (weather permitting) daily.

We work on learning our family information, colors, numbers, counting, and number recognition. We use our fine motor skills by coloring cutting, puzzles, and building blocks. Math skills are learned by counting at group and calendar. The children love learning new songs and how to become independent.

We usually begin our day by doing 'group'. This consists of counting, days of the week, who's here, name spelling, mom/dad's names, and phone numbers in case someone gets lost. We finish group by picking dong sticks and singing. We then go on to small groups.

We do try to get outside daily weather permitting. I also ask that an extra set of weather appropriate clothes be brought in in case of accidents or something spilling on your child during snack or lunch. It's always nice to have a clean, dry set of clothing to change into! During the warmer weather I ask you to bring a swimsuit, beach towel, and water bottles.

I encourage children to be self sufficient.

(I uphold an anti-bullying stance and try to have children work out problems on their own with supervision. We try to come up with ideas as to how to avoid these conflicts in the future. It is amazing how well with a little help the children can 'fix' things amongst themselves.)
