

LINCOLN ICE DETENTION CENTER ACCEPTANCE Passed

WHEREAS, President Trump is progressing aggressively with the deportation of illegal aliens for the purpose of national security,

WHEREAS, those on the left are inclined to protect illegal aliens and resist these deportations with unconventional means,

WHEREAS, Wyoming is not free of sanctuary cities supported by local law-enforcement agencies.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lincoln County Republican Party is in full support of a federally funded ICE facility being opened by refurbishing some facility or providing a temporary facility built within our state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Lincoln County Republican Party encourages the Lincoln County Sheriff to act quickly and combine resources necessary to form a Special Missions Unit(s) to work and train with other agencies within Lincoln County, Wyoming as well as other agencies, in other counties.
