## Resolution to Require Live Streaming, Recording, and Remote Public Comment for All Lincoln County Commission Meetings

**WHEREAS**, the people of Lincoln County, Wyoming, have the constitutional right to observe, participate in, and hold accountable those elected to serve them in all matters of public business; and

**WHEREAS** the Lincoln County Commission conducts official business that directly impacts the lives, property, and financial interests of county residents; and

**WHEREAS** many citizens live significant distances from Kemmerer or Afton and face hardship attending meetings in person due to geography, weather, employment, or health constraints; and

WHEREAS the technology to provide live-streamed meetings and two-way online participation is both readily available and affordable, and numerous Wyoming counties—including Sweetwater, Natrona, and Teton—already provide such public access as a standard practice; and

**WHEREAS**, ensuring transparency through video recording, archiving, and online testimony strengthens public trust, increases accountability, and preserves an accurate record of public proceedings for future reference;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the citizens of Lincoln County hereby demand that:

- 1. All meetings of the Lincoln County Commission—including regular, special, and-work sessions—be live streamed in their entirety through an accessible online platform (e.g., YouTube, Facebook Live, or the County website).
- 2. Each meeting's audio and video recording shall be archived and posted onlinewithin five (5) business days of the meeting for permanent public access.
- 3. Remote participation shall be made available for citizens wishing to offer public-comment or testify during designated agenda items, utilizing a secure online conferencing system (e.g., Zoom, Microsoft Teams, or equivalent).

- 4. The County shall ensure equal access for all by publishing clear instructions for online participation, including sign-up procedures and comment guidelines, at least 48 hours prior to each meeting.
- 5. The County shall adopt a written transparency policy codifying these practices to guarantee consistent implementation and protection of public access moving forward.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be transmitted to the Lincoln County Commissioners, the County Clerk, and the County Attorney, and that it shall remain in effect as a standing demand of the citizens until adopted and implemented.
