

**RESOLUTION OF CENSURE AND DECLARATION OF NO CONFIDENCE
IN REPRESENTATIVE ANDREW BYRON**

WHEREAS, Representative Andrew Byron, elected to serve in the Wyoming House of Representatives under the Republican Party designation, has a sworn duty to uphold the principles and platform of the Republican Party and to faithfully represent the conservative values of his constituents; and

WHEREAS, an objective review of his legislative voting record over two terms demonstrates a persistent and deliberate pattern of votes in direct opposition to the Republican Party Platform and the clearly stated priorities of Republican voters; and

WHEREAS, the Republican Party Platform is the authoritative expression of the principles, values, and policy positions adopted by the voting members of the Party; and

WHEREAS, adherence to that platform is a fundamental expectation of any elected official who seeks and receives the support, endorsement, and resources of the Republican Party; and

WHEREAS, Representative Andrew Byron has repeatedly cast votes advancing progressive and liberal policy positions inconsistent with core Republican principles of limited government, fiscal responsibility, individual liberty, and constitutional governance; and

WHEREAS, his public representations to constituents have failed to accurately reflect the substance and implications of his voting record; and

WHEREAS, such conduct constitutes a breach of trust with Republican voters and undermines the integrity, credibility, and unity of the Republican Party;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lincoln County Republican Party Central Committee hereby formally and unequivocally censures Representative Andrew Byron for conduct incompatible with the Republican Party Platform and the trust placed in him by Republican voters; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Committee declares a formal vote of no confidence in Representative Andrew Byron as a Republican officeholder and determines that he no longer represents the principles or policy positions of the Republican Party; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all party endorsement, financial support, campaign resources, and organizational assistance are immediately withdrawn; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that party resources may be directed toward informing constituents of Representative Byron's voting record and the Committee's decision to withdraw support; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Representative Andrew Byron is hereby called upon to resign his office or, at minimum, cease representing himself as aligned with the Republican Party Platform; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Committee will actively explore and support all appropriate political and lawful remedies available to Republican voters.
