

THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF Lincoln County, Wyoming, SUPPORTS INCREASED FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY PROGRAMS THAT SERVE ABUSED WOMEN

FOR EXAMPLE: TURNING POINT IN AFTON/KEMMERER, LINCOLN COUNTY, WHICH IS WILDLY UNDERFUNDED TO BE even minimally EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS, abused women in Lincoln County require access to safe housing, legal assistance, and employment support in order to secure protection and achieve long-term independence; and

WHEREAS, existing community center programs provide essential services including crisis support, temporary housing assistance, legal advocacy, and job readiness services; and

WHEREAS, continued and expanded funding is necessary to ensure these services remain available and sustainable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Central Committee of Lincoln County formally supports the allocation of funding to existing Community Center Programs serving abused women for the purpose of:

1. Providing legal assistance and court advocacy;
2. Supporting temporary and transitional housing;
3. Delivering employment training and job placement services for a defined stabilization period;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be forwarded to appropriate state officials and agencies as a formal request for state-level funding support and partnership to strengthen services across Wyoming.
