

A RESOLUTION IN FAVOR OF A PRO-LIFE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
FOR THE STATE OF WYOMING

Whereas in 2022 the US Supreme Court in the Dobbs v. JWHO decision overturned Roe v. Wade, giving individual states and their elected representatives the authority to regulate or prohibit abortion; and

Whereas the 2022 Wyoming legislature passed a pro-life trigger bill (HB0092) to go into law if and when the US Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade; and

Whereas a lower court banned the Wyoming 2022 pro-life trigger law immediately after it became law; and

Whereas on January 6, 2026 the Wyoming Supreme Court ruled the 2023 *Life Is a Human Right Act* and the *Prohibition of Chemical Abortions* statutes were unconstitutional, thereby barring all attempts by the legislature to pass pro-life legislation according to the will of the citizens of Wyoming since Roe v. Wade was overturned; and

Whereas the Wyoming Supreme Court decision left Wyoming with the most unrestricted abortion rights in the nation, leaving the pre-born unprotected until birth; and

Whereas the Wyoming Supreme Court based its decision against the legislature's pro-life statutes on the 2012 amendment to the Wyoming Constitution known as the Health Care Freedom Amendment which was originally designed to protect Wyoming citizens from being compelled to participate in a specific healthcare system under the mandate of the Affordable Care Act; and

Whereas a properly ratified constitutional amendment overrides judicial decisions; and

Whereas some states have amended their constitutions to explicitly state that their constitution does not grant a right to abortion or taxpayer-funded abortions, doing so for the specific purpose of placing the abortion issue in the hands of the people through their elected officials rather than with their unelected state court judges;

Therefore, be it resolved that in order for the abortion issue in Wyoming to be placed in the hands of the people through their elected officials rather than with their unelected state court judges, the Lincoln County Republican calls upon the Wyoming legislature to put forth a Constitutional amendment to be put on the ballot for the vote of the citizens of Wyoming stating that our Wyoming Constitution does not grant a right to abortion or taxpayer-funded abortions.
