

RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, Lincoln County is currently governed by a body of three commissioners, and,

WHEREAS, The current commission has hired a Chief of Staff who acts as gatekeeper to the commission and their agenda, and,

WHEREAS, The Chief of Staff is unaccountable to the residents of Lincoln County, and,

WHEREAS, The workload can easily be spread across 5 commissioners without the need for a Chief of Staff and at a net savings, and,

WHEREAS, There has been times when all three Commissioners were from one geographic location, leaving the rest of the County unrepresented, and,

WHEREAS, Collusion between two Commissioners can override the third and dictate policy for the entire County, and,

WHEREAS, The current Commission has supported the radical, big government agenda of the Wyoming County Commissioners Association, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the people of Lincoln County call for the expansion of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners from three to five members in order to provide better representation of and accountability to the people, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that per Wyoming State Statute, the new Board will be formed by “dividing the county into districts as nearly equal in population as practicable considering the geographic, economic and social characteristics of the county”, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board terminate the position of Chief of Staff and resume correspondence directly with the people they represent.
