Resolution Regarding Driving Without a Driver's License

WHEREAS: Vehicle insurance rates are increasing at an alarming rate in Wyoming.

WHEREAS: Wyoming, like many states, is seeing an influx of non-licensed drivers operating vehicles on our public roads and highways.

WHEREAS: There has been a large increase in the number of repeat offenders, many of them with double digit offenses, who never pay the fines levied against them and continue to drive.

WHEREAS: The current penalty for driving without a license in Wyoming is only a fine of up to \$750.

RESOLVED: That Wyoming Statute 31-7-106 be amended to provide a penalty for a second or subsequent offense to be categorized as a Class B misdemeanor with a penalty of up to six (6) months in the county jail, a fine of up to \$750, or both.
