Housing Search Tips

Housing Search Engines:

Filter the search to fit your needs:

- Unit size
- Location
- Price range
- Amenities



Helpful Housing Search Questions:

- What are the income requirements, and do I meet them?
- What are the background check requirements? Do I meet them? If not, is the unit able to be flexible?
- When is the unit available? Is it in a timeframe that will help me quickly end my housing crisis?
- What things are important to me to have in a unit (pets, location, parking, etc.)?
- What can I be flexible on if necessary to end my housing crisis?
- Does this unit meet my current housing needs?

Avoid Rental Scams!

- Be cautious giving personal info over the phone or online.
- View the listing in person. Don't go alone or tell someone where you are going.
- Make sure the listing shows lots of photos of the unit.
- Don't make a security deposit before signing the lease.
- Make sure you are signing a legally binding lease agreement.
