We are planning to do many exciting activities throughout this week. We will have special music, arts and crafts, outdoor activities, and a picnic planned. We're so excited for a weeklong celebration of our youngest learners!

Week of the Young Child Daily Themes

Monday- Painting Palooza Day

Please send your child in old clothes.

We will be doing plunger painting, syringe painting, ice painting, spaghetti painting, tooth brush painting, and painting with tissue paper. They will also be decorating a cookie with melted marshmallow paint.

Tuesday- Imagination Day

Everyone please dress up as your favorite character!

We will be making capes, character cookie cutter stamp art, crowns, wands, and eye patches. We will be having a special character breakfast and lunch.



Wednesday-Dinosaur Day

We will be making fossils with salt dough, digging for dinosaurs in the sand table, making dino print painting, and freeing a dinosaur from an ice egg. They will be have dinosaur nuggets for lunch and dinosaur bones(white chocolate covered pretzels) as part of snack.

Thursday- Bubbles and Balloons Day

The children will be making bubble blowers and creating a color mixing picture with them. We will also be doing a balloon print painting. The children will have a bubble race and bubble tag. They will be creating a balloon inspired snack.

Friday-Beach Day

Please send your child in beach themed clothes or with a bathing suit to change into, and a towel.

They will get to create a special pudding beach snack and learn how to make fresh squeeze lemonade. They will play a beach ball exercise game and crazy carnival games. The children will decorate their own sun visors. We will be having a picnic lunch outside weather permitting.
