We are excited about painting and making flowers. We are enjoying the outside playing games and exercising.

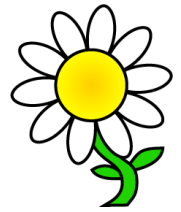
Happy April from Room 204B!!
