Toddler Themes


The Toddlers will be learning about Artic Animals and Winter Weather focusing on ice and snow.

Infant Toddler Contracted Slots Program

We have recently been awarded a grant to cover the cost of children ages 6 wks-2yrs. We are looking for eligible children to fill these slots.

Some of the benefits of this program:

- Smaller ratios 4:1
- No cost to the family
- Child automatically qualifies for Pre-K Counts Program at 3yrs old
- Goal of this program is to promote high quality care in infant and toddler classrooms and to strengthen the link between high quality childcare and high-quality pre-kindergarten programs

Cannot be receiving cash assistance

- Age: between 6 weeks and 36 months
- Children needing full week, full time care will be priority when filling slots.
