Arts- Collage Art, Crayons, Painting, Markers, Clay, Gluing

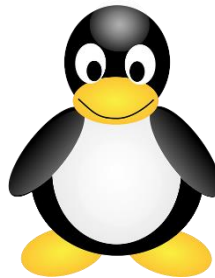
