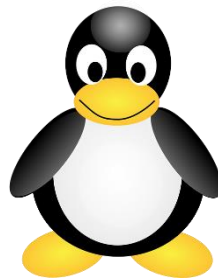

Offices

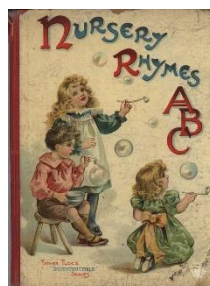
The business office is now located in the lower building. Miss Shirley is there 7:30 am until 4:30 pm. Mr. and Mrs. Millers hours vary.
