up is also the responsibility of the owner after farrier/veterinary appointments. If a CWF representative is involved in any capacity with a non-in-house service provider, a handling fee of \$20.00 will be applied. Supplements will also be given per owner's requests, instructions, and expense unless it cannot be given and eaten with grain. In the case of manual administration by CWF, there will be an additional fee agreed upon by both CWF and Owner. There will be a fee charged for any medical care provided by CWF's owner/employees. These might include but not limited to cold hosing, poulticing, and hand walking. Stall rest is an additional \$10.00 per day due to increased cleaning and shavings use. Horses will be turned out daily in winter

months and nightly in summer months. Blanketing is provided for full boarded horses.

• There is an additional monthly fee for Senior Feed.

#### (initial) 5. PASTURE BOARD:

Owner shall pay CWF for boarding services the fee of <u>\$625.00</u> per month for PASTRUE BOARD as described below.

- Pasture and run-in stall housing Grain, hay, water, regular individual feeding Use of facility

  Pasture board: Horses are turned-out 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with a run-in stall access at-all-times. It includes 2 feedings of grain per day, water, 2 feedings of Coastal hay in the winter months but may only be fed grain once a day in summer months as well as no hay. Individual feeding is provided for all horses, no sharing of meals (no group feeding). Supplements can be given but must be provided by the owner at the owner's expense (provided that it can be added in feed with no additional preparation by CWF). Any horse requiring additional feed supplements, such as but not limited to alfalfa cubes, beet pulp, and watering of grain, will be charged an additional fee for this service. Blanketing may be provided at the discretion of CWF only. An additional fee will be charged for blanketing at owner's request.
  - Pasture Board is \$625.00/per month for pellets (Limit 8 quarts or 12 lbs. per day) and Coastal Hay only.
  - Senior Feed is an additional \$(To Be Determined)/per month in addition to monthly board.
  - Blanketing per owner request is an additional \$50.00/per month in addition to monthly board.

**PASTURE BOARDED HORSES AND BLANKETS**-Pasture boarded horses live outside full-time with access to shelter at will. The need for a full protective winter coat is vital to the horse's health and cannot be substituted by blanketing. We will provide blanketing in *extreme and prolonged* inclement weather at CWF'S discretion and the individual horse's needs. There will be an additional monthly fee of \$75.00 per month for any other blanketing requests even if for only one single owner request. **NO BODY-CLIPPING** pasture boarded horses.

(initial) 6. Extra Boarding Charges: There will be additional charges for horses requiring individual turnout, special turnout, or stall confinement. Individual turnout or special turnout will be \$75.00 per month. Stall confinement is no less than \$5.00 per day. Pasture Boarded horses requiring barn board confinement will be charged full board and additional fees determined by CWF due to increase use of shavings, hay, and labor.

(initial) 7. All changes in price shall be accompanied by a thirty-day notice.


(initial) 8. The horse at-all-times shall be free from infectious, contagious, or transmissible disease. A current negative Coggins test, deworming, and immunization record are required upon arrival. A yearly Coggins test is required. CWF reserves the right to refuse a horse if not in proper health or is deemed dangerous or undesirable for CWF's boarding stable. In such case, Owner is responsible for removing horse immediately, and for all fees incurred during horse's stay. After all fees have been paid, this contract is terminated except for the indemnification provisions that shall survive termination.

(initial) 9. CWF will without liability, administer standard medications as advised by a veterinarian.

(initial) 10. Upon thirty (30) days written notice only, the Owner may terminate this contract for any reason. In such case, CWF shall be paid for all fees incurred up to the termination date. After all fees have been paid in full, this contract is terminated except for the indemnification provisions which shall survive termination. NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS will be granted for any horse leaving or departing the farm for any reason. This includes but not limited to any acts of nature, (i.e., hurricanes, flooding, tornados, and wildfires), over-night veterinary stays, or over-night pleasure trips. Owners may be assessed additional fees for preparation in any of these events due to increase staff overtime.

(initial) 11. Owner agrees to assume ANY-AND-ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM OWNERS USE OF, OR PRESENCE UPON CWF PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including but not limited to the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses, dogs, or other stationary objects, fire or explosions, or the unavailability of emergency medical care, or the negligence or deliberate act of another person.

(initial) 12. Owner agrees to indemnify and hold CWF and Island Creek Land Co. LLC and all its successors, assignees, subsidiaries, franchises, affiliated, officers, directors, employees, agents, trainers, instructors, independent contractors, and bystanders completely harmless and release them from all liability whatsoever and agrees not to sue them. Owner agrees to indemnify and defend CWF against and hold it harmless from any-and-all claims, causes of action, charges, judgments, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees, which in any way arise from Owner's use and/or presence upon CWF property and facilities.



### (initial) 21. Required Vaccinations:

- Proof of a negative Coggins test within one year
- Flu vaccine
- Tetanus vaccine
- Eastern and Western encephalitis vaccine (EEE/WEE)
- Rhino Vaccine
- Rabies (RV)
- West Nile Virus
- Strangles (Recommended but not required)
- Potomac Horse Fever (Recommended but not required)

(initial) 22. In the event that it shall become necessary for CWF to employ an attorney to enforce its right under this Boarding Contact, CWF may recover its attorney's fees.

# (initial) 23. LAW: THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA.

(initial) 24. If owner defaults on board payment for 2 months (2 months behind on board payment), CWF will possess and sell said horse or pony for payment of delinquent account without notice to owner.
