Your Home! Light Wood In Pastel Rooms



In some rooms, a breakfast of mahogany would be too heavy in color. When the room is decorated in light colors and furniture is of a delicate design, the large bulk of such a breakfast might throw the room off scale.

The photograph shows a breakfast of old deal, which is the English name for Norway pine. Deal has a beautiful grain and has been used for furniture in England for several centuries. This breakfast bookcase was made from an old cabinet; probably the cabinet was too large for present-day living and the fine old wood was put to this use. It is a lovely piece, with broken pediment and carved classical moldings, and would be excellent for a living room where such light wood is desirable.

Breakfronts are especially decorative because the objects placed on their shelves add so much to the whole effect. Usually the shelves are built in line with the dividing strips of the glazing. Books or china look equally well on them, and the latter can follow a desired color scheme. Sometimes both are displayed in a well-distributed manner.

The Hepplewhite arm chair, made in England, is a copy of an old one and has the traditional shield back, with an embossed upholstery. This is a style well suited to a room where such a breakfast is used.

The little stand is topped by a plated silver tray with a pierced gallery. These stands are very useful for a glass or ash tray and take up little room, an advantage in these days of limited space.

We have several interesting ash trays. One used in our studio is an old Italian charcoal brazier. It has a finely designed wrought-iron stand supporting a shallow basin, also of metal, with an embossed design and a scalloped edge. It is decorative and practical.

Another pair of ash trays was made from antique Sheffield bedroom tray-type candlesticks. The candleholder is used for matches, and the tray base makes an excellent ash tray. They are just the right size. Old brass ones are also good, especially for country living rooms furnished in pine.
