On November 7, 2017, Village of Moscow residents voted to approve an opt-out electric aggregation program for eligible Village residents and small businesses. After adopting a Plan of Operation and Governance for the program, the Village entered into an agreement with Energy Alliances, Inc. to provide consulting services for obtaining the electric generation and supply for this program. Specific information for this program follows:

- **Supplier:** AEP Energy, Inc.
- **Rate:** 4.49¢ per kWh
- **Term:** Through the July 2023 meter read date.

- Your local utility, Duke Energy-Ohio, will continue to deliver your electricity and maintain the electric lines and respond to emergencies.
