

PHI

- Protected health information (PHI) – information related to the:
- Past, present, or future physical or mental health or condition of an individual
- Provision of health care to an individual
- Past, present, or future payment for the provision of health care to an individual

ePHI

Electronic protected health information (ePHI) - PHI that is transmitted by electronic media; maintained in electronic media; transmitted or maintained in any other electronic form or medium.

Note: Information for deceased individuals continues to be PHI until the individual has been deceased for more than 50 years.

UPWARD TRENDS OF FINES


In February 7, 2019 OCR concluded an all-time record year in HIPAA enforcement activity.

In 2018, OCR settled cases totaling \$28.7 million. This total surpassed the previous record of \$23.5 million from 2016 by 22 percent. This trend is expected to continue.

Penalties for HIPAA Email Violations PER EMAIL		
HIPAA Standard	Min	Max
Could not have avoided with reasonable care	\$100	\$50 <i>,</i> 000
HIPAA email violation despite reasonable care	\$1,000	\$50,000
Willful Neglect – Corrected within reasonable time	\$10,000	\$50,000
Willful Neglect – Not corrected	\$50,000	\$1,500,000

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
