


In an uncertain world find hope, joy, peace, and freedom in the word of God

READ YOUR BIBLE!

The title says it all and this is the main reason why I am happy to review and recommend this book. Any book that will encourage people (Christian or non-Christian) to open the Bible and read it is one that I will recommend because so many people have never opened the “world’s bestseller” and many Christians no longer read the Bible daily. It is time this trend is reversed.

READ YOUR BIBLE! is an easy read and very accessible to all. One of its appeals is that it is not written by a professional theologian, but by a layman. The text is easy to understand and thoughtfully researched. Some conclusions of the author you may not agree with, but it should prompt further investigation.

READ YOUR BIBLE! will give you an overall introduction to the Bible, explain the structure of its 66 books and how they fit together. Half of the text are excerpts from the Bible itself so it is not just about the Bible: you are reading the Bible as you read the book.

READ YOUR BIBLE! contains a number of appendices – half the book’s content. These include a long but easy to read story about God’s people from the creation to the end of the world. Another gives you a daily Bible reading plan to enable you to read the entire Bible in one year.

What I particularly appreciated was the way “*READ YOUR BIBLE!*” keeps emphasizing the God of the Bible, His nature and His character. But it is not just about God; it highlights the fact that a personal relationship with God is the central purpose of the Bible. Because relationship with God is what the Bible is all about, the person of Jesus is central to God’s plan of Salvation, in both the Old and New Testaments. If the reader realises this, they will understand why the subtitle of “*READ YOUR BIBLE!*” speaks of finding hope, joy, peace and freedom in the word of God.

This is a book that will not only familiarise you with the Bible, its structure and its content, but could well be lifechanging.
