


THE ST ANDREWS INVITATIONAL

Located just a short stroll from the historic university town of St Andrews, this iconic venue is great vacation spot for golfers and non-golfers alike.







Castle Course

The newest addition to St Andrews Links, The Castle Course opened in 2008 becoming the seventh course at the Home of Golf. Set on a rugged cliff-top with spectacular views over St Andrews, it offers a memorable golfing experience.

CARNOUSTIE GOLF LINKS

In 2018, The Open returned to Carnoustie for the 8th time. Golf has been played on the Angus links since the early 16th century, and in that time Carnoustie has earned a well-deserved reputation as one of the toughest courses in the world. Great Champions including Ben Hogan, Gary Player and Tom Watson tasted success in The Open at Carnoustie.



DUMBARNIE LINKS

Dumbarnie Links has quickly become one of the most talked-about courses in Scottish golf. Located on the north shore of the Firth of Forth, a mere 9 miles from the centre of St Andrews, it occupies some of the most revered links turf in the whole of the world.

This unquestionably unique Clive Clark masterpiece is sure to become one of the “bucket list” courses in Scotland.



KINGSBARN'S GOLF LINKS

Opened in 2000, Kingsbarn's is one of the newer golf courses in Scotland, but it has quickly garnered a large following.
