## SCHOLARSHIP



**Current high school seniors** compete for one of 198 scholarships to help pay for college or trade/vocational/technical school after graduation.

- 12 scholarships at \$10,000 each.
- 12 scholarships at \$2,500 each.
- 12 scholarships at \$7,500 each.
- 150 scholarships at \$1,000 each.
- 12 scholarships at \$5,000 each.

### CONTINUING **FDUCATION**



High school grads of all ages can apply for a \$2,500 grant to help with their education costs. Up to 50 grants are awarded to qualified members on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Adults wanting to go back to school, obtain a master's degree or earn a designation.
