MAY SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: May 29, 2026 & June 26, 2026

1) Coherent / II-VI Foundation Scholarship - \$10,000 - 47 Awards (Deadline: May 29, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be entering the fields of engineering, mathematics or science.
- B) Have a GPA of 3.3 or above.

2) Future Teacher Scholarship Program - \$6,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: May 29, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have taken at least two years of the same language in high school.
- B) Be committed to pursuing the language teaching profession in languages other than English.

3) Niche Scholarship - \$25,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school or a current college student.
- B) Be attending or planning to attend college, university, or professional training school in the Fall of 2026.

4) Veilant STEM Scholarship - \$5,000 – 3 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior entering college in a STEM field or a current undergraduate student.
- B) Be a U.S. citizen enrolled in U.S. college or university for the next academic year.

5) AIAS Foundation Scholarship Fund - \$2,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Plan to pursue a career in any aspect of game development including but not limited to: art, animation, programming, engineering, game direction, game design, sound design, law, marketing, and business.
- B) Be a full-time undergraduate student or a graduate student attending an accredited college or university during the 2026-27 academic school year.

6) Asian American Architects and Engineers Scholarship - \$5,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be full-time student working towards a degree in one of the following: Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Urban Design, Civil Engineering, Structural Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Construction, or Interior Design.

7) College Here I Come Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior.
- B) Be an undergraduate student at an accredited college or university during the 2026-27 school year.

8) JFLF's Welding Awards Program - \$1,000 – 95 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be 18 years or younger and currently enrolled in a school or training program.
- B) Submit written reports about the welding projects you have completed. The welding project may be a structure, a repair or an item made for home, farm or shop.

9) SOPREMA Scholarship - \$5,000 – 5 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to enroll in full-time undergraduate or graduate study at an accredited college or university for the upcoming academic year.
- B) Be pursuing a degree in architecture, engineering, construction management or a similar field.

- B) Must own and operate a small business for at least the past six months.
