Aunt Betty's Technical Career Scholarship

To benefit residents of Knox and Laurel counties, KY (including Barbourville), Campbell, Claiborne, Grainger, Hancock, Hawkins, Loudon, Morgan, and Union counties, TN enrolled in a career and technical post-secondary program. Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500

Josey Baker Memorial Scholarship

To benefit students from Northeast Tennessee and Southwest Virginia pursuing an agriculture or construction-related course of study.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500 one-time award for one year

Butterfly Fund Memorial Scholarship

To assist graduating high school seniors and current college students pursuing a career in a broad variety of fields within pediatric oncology. Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$2,500 one-time award for one year

Cherish the Child Legacy Scholarship

To provide scholarship assistance to eligible students, age 25 or younger, who are or were foster care participants or who received services from Smoky Mountain Children's Home.

Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$4,500 one-time award for one year

James K. Goldston Cybersecurity Scholarship

Graduating high school seniors, college/university students and adult students pursuing undergraduate programs of study in computer science, computer engineering, cyber science, cybersecurity, or enrollment in an NSA National Center for Academic Excellence in Cybersecurity program. Recipients and former applicants may reapply for this scholarship.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,800 one-time award for one year

Brittany Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Brittany Johnson to assist graduating high school seniors and current college students who were on their high school's basketball team in pursuing an undergraduate degree, with preference given to female basketball players attending or planning to attend Maryville College

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Barbara G. Kirkpatrick Memorial Scholarship

To assist single parent students pursuing a four-year undergraduate degree at East Tennessee State University. Graduating high school seniors, current college students, GED recipients, or returning adult students may apply.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500 one-time award for one year

Valkyrie-Thor Scholarship in Theatre Arts Fund

To assist graduating high school seniors and college students from ETF's 25-county region studying theatre arts at Pellissippi State Community College, Roane State Community College, University of Tennessee, Knoxville, or Maryville College.

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$5,000 one-time award for one year

Debbie Van Cleave Scholarship

The scholarship is intended to benefit legally blind students from ETF's 25-county service area to pursue higher education. Applicants must be blind with vision of 20/200 or less in the better eye **after** correction and/or a visual field reduced to 20 degrees or less. Graduating high school seniors, current college/university students, GED recipients, and returning adult students may apply.

Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,400 one-time award for one year

Haley Elise Van Pelt Scholarship: Established to benefit students of any age seeking post-secondary education who have a permanent intellectual or developmental disability and/or functional impairment.
*NOTE: Applications will be available for this scholarship on April 1, 2024. Application deadline is June 1, 2024.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,500 one-time award for one year

Brilla Mallicoat Young Scholarship

For graduating seniors of Grainger High School, Washburn School, and Hancock County High School pursuing programs of study leading to certification as a Registered Nurse and/or Bachelor's degree in Nursing.

Scholarship Amount: \$3,600 one-time award for one year

Coach Gary A. Walker "Making a Difference" Wrestling Scholarship

To benefit graduating high school seniors (male or female) who have been members of their high school wrestling team. Preference will be given to Carter High School and Halls High School students. **Note:** Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year
