Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Applicants must **have a GPA of 3.4 or higher** and plan to attend a 2- or 4-year college or technical school
- * Scholarship funds will be paid ***directly to the institution in which the scholarship recipient is actively enrolled for fall 2020***
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. ***Application deadline is April 30, 2020.*** Late applications are not accepted.

Turn in application along with Guidance Counselor endorsement, including proof of GPA.

*GPA standard may be waived on a case by case basis with proof of extenuating circumstances
