Statement of Recovery Residence Rights

- 1. The right to live in an environment that supports your recovery.
- 2. The right to choose your own personal recovery goals.
- 3. The right to participate actively in your recovery.
- 4. The right to be verbally informed of all resident rights in a manner that the resident will understand.
- 5. The right to request a written copy of all resident rights and the grievance procedure.
- 6. The right to exercise one's own rights without reprisal, except that no right extends so far as to supersede health and safety considerations.
- 7. The right to file a grievance in accordance with name of house policy, and to file a complaint to the owner/operator without fear of retaliation and to have the complaint addressed within a reasonable amount of time.
- 8. The right to be treated with courtesy and respect at all times, and with consideration for personal dignity, autonomy and privacy.
- 9. The right to confidentiality of communications and personal identifying information that are only to be accessible to designated staff and which can be released to others only with your written consent, except as allowed within the limitations and requirements for disclosure of resident information under state and federal laws and regulations.
- 10. The right to have access to one's own record.
- 11. The right not to be discriminated against on the basis of race, ethnicity, age, religion, sex, familial status, national origin, disability, ancestry, or in any manner prohibited by local, state or federal laws.
- 12. The right to practice a religion of his or her choice or to abstain from the practice of religion.
- 13. The right to be informed in writing of the rates charged by the recovery house, as well as any additional charges.
- 14. The right to be fully informed before changes occur in these rights and responsibilities as well as to changes in policies and procedures should they occur.
- 15. The right not to be locked out of the recovery house at any time.
- 16. The right not to be locked in the recovery house at any time for any reason.

- 17. The right to consult with an independent treatment specialist or legal counsel at one's own expense.
- 18. The right not to be deprived of any legal rights, including landlord tenant rights and fair housing rights solely by reason of residence in the recovery house.
- 19. The right to retain personal property and possessions, unless prohibited by house policy nor which jeopardize your and others' safety or health.
- 20. The right to full explanation regarding the loss or restriction of housing privileges, and methods to reinstate the privileges.
- 21. The right to request and receive in a timely manner a written receipt for any payments made or statement of account that details any expenses, charges and payments made.
- 22. The right to receive and send unopened mail.
- 23. The right to be referred to subsequent services upon leaving or transfer from this residence if necessary.
- 24. The right not to be required to perform services for the residence, which are not included in the usual expectations for all residents.
