## Moral Reconation Therapy (MRT) Virtual Adult Courses

## What is MRT?

MRT is a systematic, cognitive-behavioral, stepby-step, treatment strategy designed to enhance self-image, promote growth of a positive, productive identity, and facilitate the development of higher stages of moral reasoning. All of these goals are ultimately demonstrated by more appropriate behavior on the part of the program participants. Over 120 outcome studies show that MRT significantly increases moral reasoning levels, enhances life purpose, facilitates increased social support, and gives participants more perceived control over their lives. Consistent research outcomes from a host of MRT implementations shows that MRT participants have significantly lower levels of rearrests and reincarcerations in comparison to appropriate controls. These results have been confirmed even in participants who have been released from the program for a full 10 years. MRT is widely recognized as an "evidence-Based Practice" as well as a "Best Practice" by numerous official government agencies and treatment authorities.
