#### "What's the point"

Scripture calls for the meeting

of God's people in several places. The disciples are told by Jesus to lean on each other, to pray together, and to continually be together. Jesus says, where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am also. We hear the exhortation from Paul to many of the churches he writes to, encouraging them to continue to meet together, but to change the way they prioritize things or perhaps examine the manner in which, and the reason for why they are able to meet together and worship.

It's so we can lean on one another and not lose heart that, no matter what, Jesus is with us and continues to give us help and hope!

So, what's the point of having the church, it's to continue to allow Jesus to be uplifted and us to be continually inspired by him.
