
### Helping Hands Needed to Fill the eggs-for the Easter Egg **Hunt Event-following**

### **RUTH'S HARVEST-of HACC**

Ruth's Harvest began 10 years ago as an outreach initiative that supplies weekend meals for children in several of our loacal elementary schools in the Hanover Area. Each child receives a package containing 2 breakfasts, 5 entrees, vegetables, fruit 3 snacks, and a beverages for the weekend.

Currently the Ruth's Harvest team assembles 200 Weekend packages from October through May of each school year.

We are spoltlighting this outreach to give church members the opportunity to get involved with our Ruth's Harvest Mission. While we do receive and welcome monetary donations, we are seeking contributions of food items from our local churches. We have set up a schedule we thing might work best to facilitate participation.

- January: individual cans of tuna
- February: Single serve packages of Macaroni and Cheese.
- March: Single serve of any Chef Boyardee Ravioli, Spagehetti, or other pasta entrée
- April: Single serve soup (Chicken Noodle, Chicken and stars, Cup of Noodles).
- May: single serve Cereal, Granola bars, Oatmeal.

Canned items we prefer have easy open tops if possible. We welcome snacks such as individual sizes of fruit roll-ups, chips, popcorn, or pretzels, etc.
