describes the image of quietness. Lately I've come to really appreciate the silence. I know, people are going to say, well Brandon, you're an extravert, you're a pastor, you love being around people. Well yes, I am, and I do! But I also enjoy the time when I can be alone, when I can recharge. I feel the quiet spirit of God anointing me, refreshing me in the silence.

The hymn is number 301 in our blue hymnal, and it reads in the refrain as follows. "" Blessed quietness, holy quietness, what assurance in my soul. On a stormy sea, speaking peace to me, how the billows cease to role.""

Gosh friends, I think of the church, the state it's in, where we're considering our role in the twenty-first century moving forward and I wonder, don't we need this? Could we not tap into this blessed quietness from Jesus even as we go about our activities, our ministry to the world?
