Pas or's Page "Gift Opening!" By Pastor Brandon

It is truly a joy during this time of year to open gifts, to see expressions on children's faces. Even to hear adults enjoy those colorfully wrapped packages and oo and ah over the gratitude behind those physical blessings. Doesn't this season of gifts, which actually extends for the twelve days of Christmas tide remind us truly of the joy of not just gift giving and receiving, but gift opening? The Meat Canning chicken sent to Haiti was finally received. The shipments were sent in small amounts to avoid gangs that may steal it.




Cookies for the Carlisle Truckstop Ministry

There are 2 worship services every Sunday.
