Bandam & Guingklo Water Project Update



1. January 27 – February 8, 2025: Catholic Engineering Corps (CEC) Cameroon mission to provide water, sanitation and hygiene services to 6,400 people.
2. May 19, 2025: CEC partners with 2 communities, bringing 15% Cash for capital construction, as well as 18 Rotary Clubs, Spirit of Christ Church and generous donors give matching grant application to Rotary International.
3. July 7, 2025 –Grant Application approved for funding from Rotary International
4. December 19, 2025 – Rotary funding approved! To come January 2026

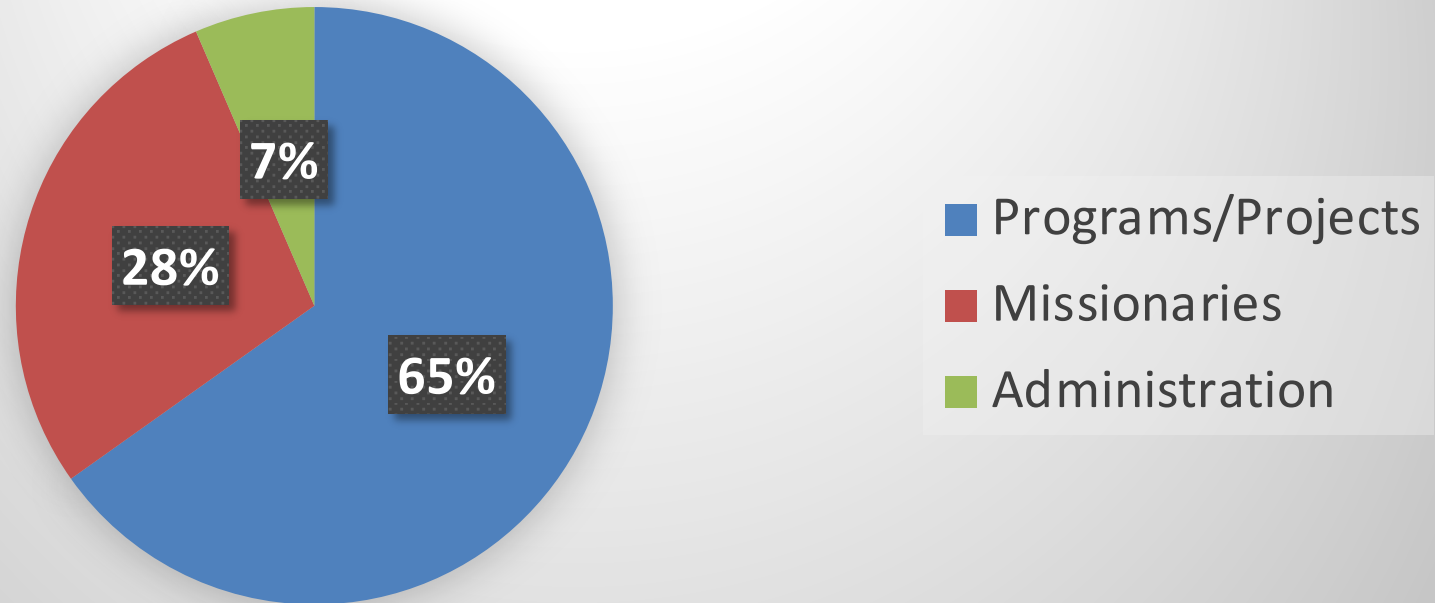




Fundraised and Leveraged Fund Use 2025

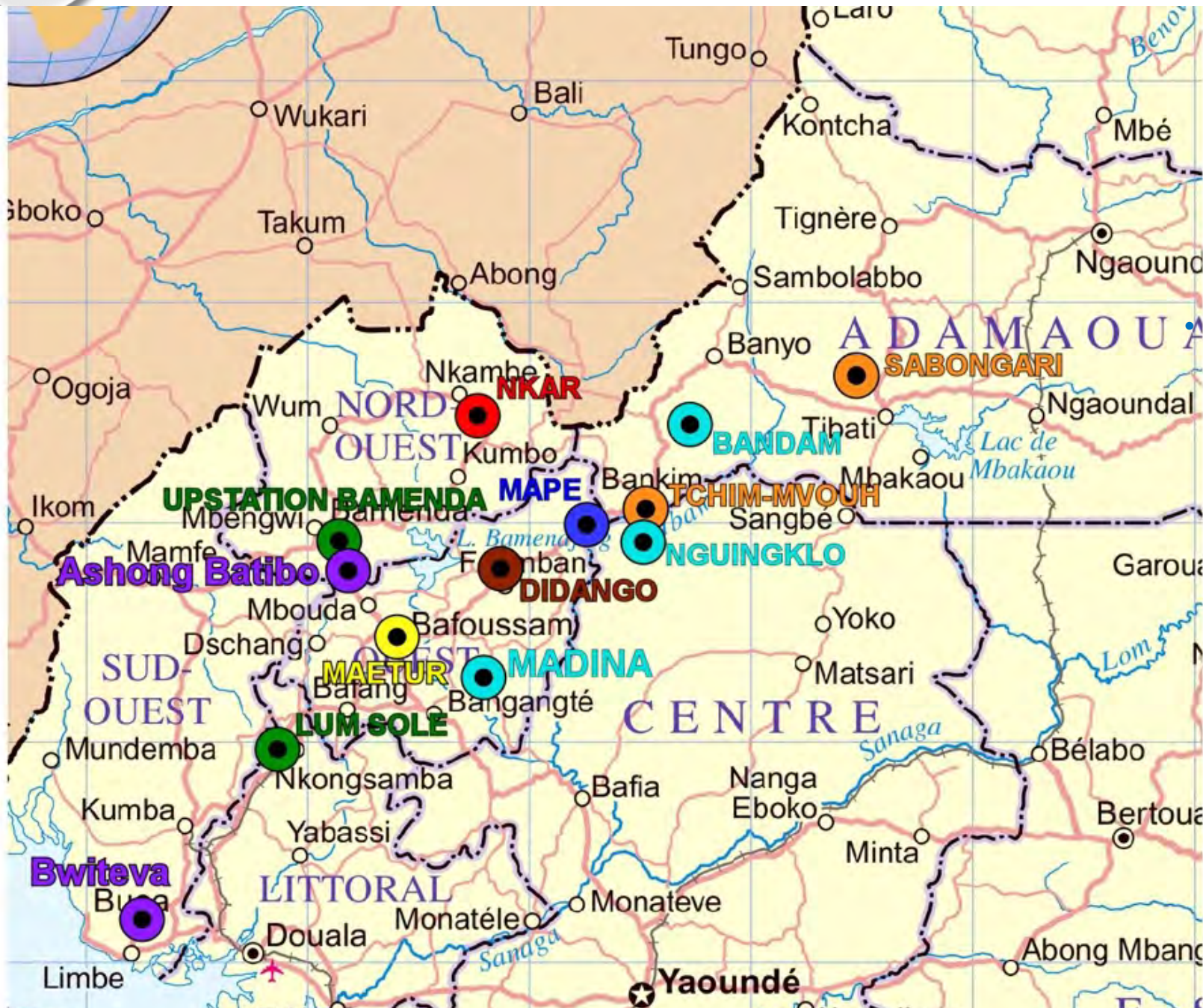

- Add 1–2 new **parish partners**
- Respond to 1–2 **disasters** with engineering and pastoral support
- Participate in 1–2 WASH or mission **conferences**
- Recruit more **volunteers, advisors, and missionaries**
- Host the first **Living Water Run**
- **Mentor** young engineers for lasting impact
- Grow **recurring support** through **Living Water Mission Partners**

Goal: Complete two water projects, begin two more, prepare the next two-village pipeline, and expand CEC's parish-based missionary engineering model.
