RVSM Radio is a friendly Radio Station. Broadcasting on many platforms to reach the masses. Its inspirational mission text is quoted from the book of Revelation 14:6... Chaplain Dr. Jerome Lowe received the vision to launch this Radio Station to reach the community with religious music and bible based instructions, preaching and health lectures and assisting with spiritual needs through prayer. This vision gave rise to the acquiring of equipment since the first quarter of 2016 with the encouragement of Minister Wayne Johnson and Minister Cora Williamson, President and vice president of voice of praise TV in Brooklyn New York.

The mission was officially launched in the first quarter of 2020 with the tireless assistance from Pastor Johnny Castor, Director of Clear Word Network in Orlando Florida. Just in case one might be wondering about the meaning of the acronym of RVSM. R is for Righteousness, V is for Victory, S represents Salvation and M is for Mission. Spreading this good news of salvation to the entire world that Jesus Christ offers His righteousness to the sinner and when we accept it, He gives us Victory from sin, then imparts salvation and then this empowers us with this great Mission of Hope to tell the world that Jesus saves and is coming soon.

RVSM Radio was launched by Chaplain Jerome Lowe and his wife Carla in the Tampa Bay Area in Florida as a local Christian radio station. The purpose of RVSM Radio station is to connect with the community, through a variety of community groups and organization services in providing ministry support.

The secondary purpose of RVSM Radio is not for Reduce, Vertical, Separation, Minimums above 29,000 Ft, which is an aviation acronym which Chaplain Lowe is very much acquainted with being an aviator with the United States Department of Transportation.

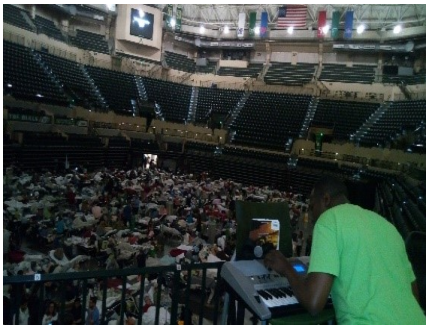
Why did you use the letters RVSM and what's its meaning many have been asking? (**RVSM**) is defined as the reduction of vertical space between aircraft from 2,000 to 1,000 feet at flight levels from 29,000 feet up to 41,000 feet. **RVSM** was implemented as a means to increase **airspace** capacity and access to more fuel-efficient flight levels.

This may have given him inspiration to name the company with the same acronym. The purpose is to provide hope during our current changing world of uncertainty, through bible centered ministry. The musical selection aired are predominantly sacred religious music and about 5% of contemporary Christian music. These musical selection spans from many cultures of the world, which gives an international diverse flavor.



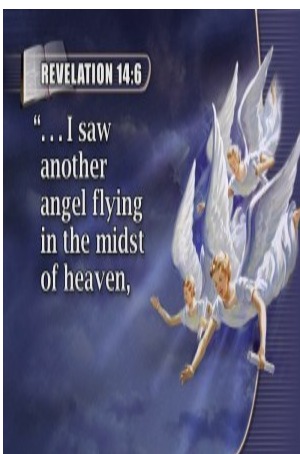
Carla, Chaplain Lowes wife, kept reiterating that she felt the Lord calling her into part time ministry with the radio station and now has to prioritize her day well, prior to attending her regular job. She is very dedicated and instrumental in providing encouragement and support primarily to the Spanish communities. She is very committed to the mission of RVSM Radio and is always willing to go the extra mile in ministry as the operations officer in being a positive resource to the community and radio listeners. Chaplain Jerome Lowe, a true visionary said in an interview that if he was told when he started his aviation and ministry career many years ago that God was preparing him for Radio Broadcasting he would have laugh at the idea. He said even during his many years in Bible Seminary, he had never thought that he even had the voice for radio. He then hastened to say that after several years of flying airplanes across the big blue sky, he realized that every time he is in the clouds and enters precarious situations, communication, navigation and having faith in God made the difference. So faith in God always makes the difference. Hebrews 11:16 says, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."



Just as how RVSM rated airplanes are equip to fly high altitudes and in minimum separation conditions, so is RVSM Radio extending to high altitudes locally and internationally to get the gospel that is charged with hope all over the world. He is brought to focus on the importance of trusting in God even when we cannot see our way, this he calls excessing active faith. He compares and contrast his Faith in the aircraft's navigational systems and structure with having faith in Jesus Christ even when we go through uncertain times of trials. Chaplain spent many years serving as a clinical healthcare and military chaplain. A MESSAGE OF HOPE



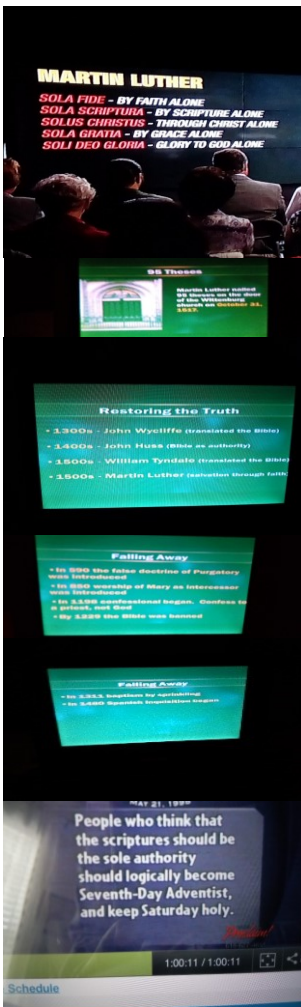

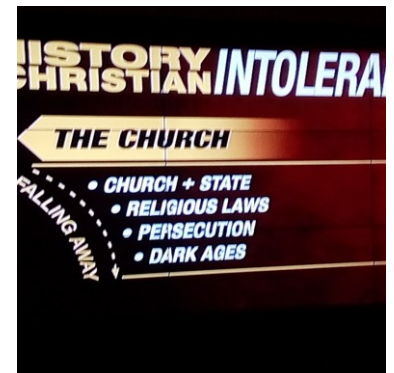
Great Protestant reformers who shared the same hope
