Motion by Wenzlick supported by Haney to: Transfer \$5,000 from Road Budget to Surplus Funds. From Surplus Funds transfer \$5,000 to Attorney Budget. Motion Passed 5-0

Wenzlick reported on the Earned Sick Leave Act. Tabled until next month.
