County Administrator, Mary Catherine Hanna, informed all that the County is undertaking the creation of a “master Plan” or “Vision Document” and a survey will be sent out to local units of government. She has hired a Deputy Administrator for Grants that may be able to assist with seeking funds for future project needs. Boasted that Saginaw County is the only county in the state to add Agricultural Land. Took questions from the Board and those in attendance. Both Sarah Tomac and Ed Theile urged all in attendance to Support the Castle Museum Millage.
