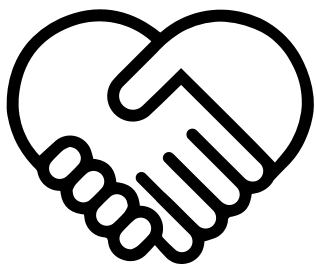
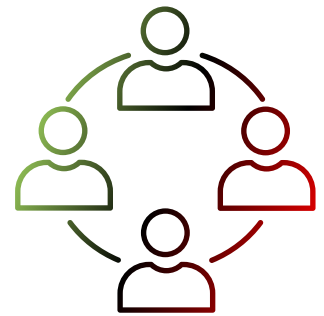

"The Milly-Rose Stirrup Foundation has been set up in memory of our very much loved & missed daughter, Milly-Rose.

Milly passed away very suddenly and unexpectedly in February 2023, at the age of just 6 and a half years old. Milly was beautiful, brave, incredibly loving and had already shown a strong desire to help others, having completed charity work of her own for causes close to her heart.

Our aim is to create a legacy in Milly-Rose's name, to relieve the distress of parents and families who have suffered this immeasurable loss. During those first few hours, and days after Milly passed away, we became aware of how small changes can make a big difference, and that things need to change.

Whilst nothing will ever take the pain away, we hope we can help hold families in their time of need, with the provision of a more personalised approach to the care of their little one, by providing items for bereavement rooms, clothing for the child, cuddle blankets, and other support we identify along the way. We hope to be able to work alongside other charities, by speaking at training events and in any other ways we can."

Highlighting the extraordinary work The Milly-Rose Stirrup Foundation has accomplished in her honour:

- **Macclesfield – The Bluebell Suite:** The Foundation has funded a family room with an adjoining viewing room, featuring a cuddle cot for late-stage pregnancy loss and a cuddle blanket for older children. This project, which included over £7,000 worth of donations, allows parents precious time with their children after they've passed. Furnishings such as a sofa, armchairs, coffee sets, and bereavement books, alongside hand-casting kits, baby blankets, and more, will create a calming space for grieving families - The suite will be completed before the event.
- **Royal Manchester Children's Hospital:** The Foundation has renovated a Family Support Room, which provides a private space for difficult conversations, just off the A&E department where Milly passed. Cuddle blankets, hand-casting kits, bereavement books, and bedding have all been donated. In a moving moment, you recently met the first parent to use a hand-casting kit donated by Milly's charity.
- **Leighton Hospital:** A cuddle blanket has been donated to their paediatric department, and there are plans for future contributions.
- **Stockport – Stepping Hill Hospital:** The Foundation is extending support for families, from late pregnancy loss through to paediatric loss, ensuring they have resources and comfort during their most challenging times.

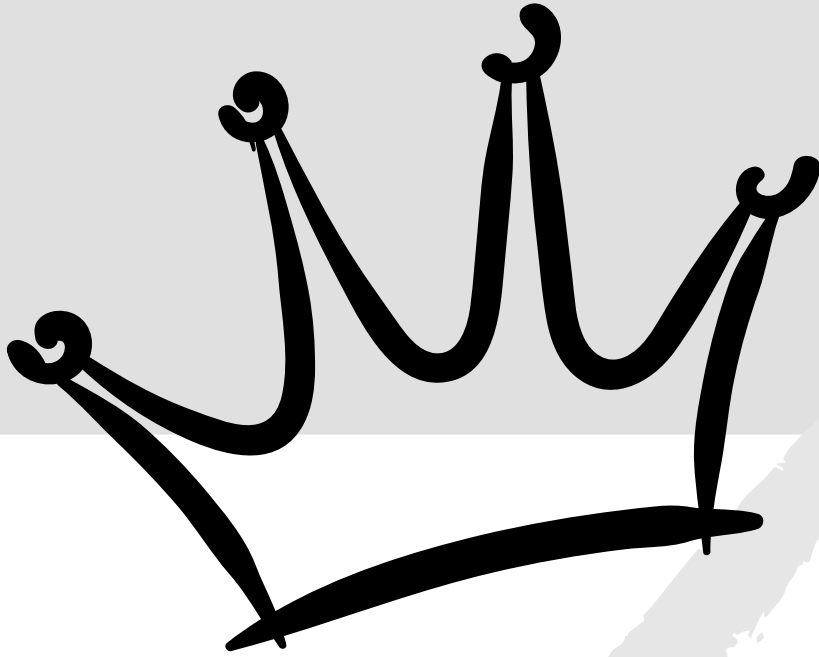
