#### INTRODUCTION

The guidelines found in this Brand Standards Guide have been established as the approved representation of Centennial High School. The school's identity should be managed with consistency and discipline across all communication materials. Proper reproduction of these marks protects and strengthens the integrity of the Centennial High School brand.

These guidelines provide direction for commercial vendors for all elements of the Centennial High School graphic identity including logos, wordmarks and color reproduction. Commercial vendors are required to obtain necessary permission to reproduce or distribute any and all marks pertaining to Centennial High School. Reproduction of any logos or wordmarks is prohibited without the approval of the Administrative Office of Centennial High School.

#### LOGO COMPONENTS

Versatility is at the heart of the creation of CHS's new brand. The ability to mix and match our various logo components will enable us to create fresh, new looks while remaining within the confines of the CHS brand. Pages 6 through 12 show the various logo components available. Digital files in .EPS, .JPG and .PNG formats exist for all logo components and are archived in the Administrative Office. Simply contact our Administrative Office and specify the file name of the logo you need.

#### **LOCKUP LOGOS**

A variety of designs have been created using various logo components. Pages 13 through 15 of this document display six composited versions of the CHS brand and their corresponding digital file names. Contact our Administrative Office and specify the file name of the design you need.

#### **OFFICIAL COLORS**

The Centennial High School color scheme has been selected to work in print, embroidery, on digital displays and for web browsers. All colors should be selected with the intended medium in mind.

**Note:** Due to the inconsistent nature of computer monitors, the colors depicted within this guide may not match the actual PANTONE® colors. When specifying colors, please refer to the PANTONE® number for accurate color reproduction.





#### CHOOSING THE PROPER FILE

In an effort to be as versatile as possible, multiple variations of each logo have been developed and approved. Digital files in .EPS, .JPG and .PNG file formats exist for most logo components and are archived in the Administrative Office. Simply contact the office and specify the file name of the logo along with the color mode and file format that best suits your needs.

#### **FILE NAME**

Effort has been taken to simplify the selection of the file that best suits your needs. The example at right demonstrates how to read what is contained in the file.

#### **COLOR MODE**

Select CMYK and PMS when printing ink on any physical surface. Select RGB for digital purposes.

#### .EPS FILE FORMAT


This format is a vector, Adobe Illustrator-based file format. It will render the best reproduction of all file formats. It can be enlarged to any size without image degradation. It is best used when actual ink is being printed on paper or fabric, among other uses.

#### .JPG FILE FORMAT

Since this format is created as RGB, it is best used in a digital environment. However, there are limitations to its use. Enlarging the file will rapidly degrade the image's resolution and will cause it to pixelate. Note that the background is white and therefore, is best used against a white surface.

#### .PNG FILE FORMAT

Like the .JPG format, .PNG is created as RGB and is best used in a digital environment. The main difference between the two file formats is that .PNG has a clear background which enables it to be placed on colored surfaces without the inherent white box that accompanies .JPGs.

#### **POWER CAT LOGOS**

Centennial High School has an ongoing agreement with Kansas State University for the unrestricted use of their Power Cat logo for any branding purposes CHS may need. #### **POWER C LOGOS**



#### **CENTENNIAL WORDMARKS**

The Centennial Wordmark is a custom font created solely for CHS. The concept behind the design was to subtly represent the school as part of the state of Tennessee. The abbreviation TENN has been slightly enlarged as well as the inclusion of a stylized depiction of the shape of the state in the horizontal cross bars.

Utilizing the same style font as the new Centennial Wordmark, a CHS monogram was created integrating the Power Cat.


