Dear Parents and Carers

We've had a busy week in Reception this week! In Maths we have been counting actions and sounds. The children have been practising the skill of counting 'in their head' as they hear a sound or see an action. On Monday the children were excited for us to use some musical instruments such as tambourines and triangles during our Maths teaching session. The children listened carefully to how many beats of the drum they heard and then showed us the number on their number fan. The children were so engaged and so keen to show us they could do it. The children have also enjoyed being able to have a go themselves outside during Maths choosing time.



In Literacy we've been looking at the book 'Funnybones'. The children have really enjoyed the story and have particularly enjoyed making our own class skeletons. We've discussed how many bones there are in a human's body, there are 206! We've also enjoyed looking at x-rays and labelling the bones on our class skeleton. The children are very keen to continue this by writing their own labels on sticky notes.

This week we've also been learning all about Remembrance Day. We've discussed what it is and what it means and why some people choose to wear poppies. The children have shown great maturity in their approach to this topic and we were particularly impressed on Wednesday when the children stood outside and listened carefully as Mr Richings spoke to the whole school about Remembrance Day. The children then stood and participated in a two-minute silence. Well done Reception!
