How to make your gift tax effective

Under the government's Gift Aid Scheme, providing you pay income tax (includes Capital Gains Tax), all your donations can now be treated as Gift Aid. This means that for every £1 that you donate, we at Robertswood can claim 25p back from the taxman.

For example:

You give £10	Taxman adds £2.50	School receives £12.50
You give £30	Taxman adds £7.50	School receives £37.50
You give £50	Taxman adds £12.50	School receives £62.50

Please note that if you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment Tax Return

If you and your spouse/partner are both tax payers, then both declare it so that donations made in either name will apply. Please contact the school office for a second declaration form.

To make your gift tax effective, simply tick the box, complete the donor details, sign and date the certificate below. Thank you.

- As an income tax payer, I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in any tax year (6th April to 5th April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities and community amateur sports clubs to which I donate, including the Robertswood School Fund, will reclaim on my gifts for that current tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT or Council Tax do not qualify. I will notify Robertswood School if I wish to cancel this declaration or if I change my name or home address or of any change in my tax status. I understand that the Robertswood charity will reclaim 25p of tax for every £1 that I have given and will give whilst my child/ren are at the school.
