



Robertswood School School Uniform

We expect all children from Reception to Year 6 to comply with the school's dress code. Children in the nursery are encouraged to wear the school jumper/cardigan and the P.E. polo shirt; the most important thing is that the children are dressed appropriately for the weather and that their clothing is easy to manage independently.

The code is in place for the following reasons:

- To promote a sense of belonging to the Robertswood School community.
- To promote safety in and out of school.
- To stop comments relating to and pressure to buy designer labels.

* These items are available from the Uniform Shop in Cheena House which is open every Friday 8.20am – 9.00am.

** Shoes should be flat and black. They should be plain with the majority not being of a trainer-type material but more like a leathery material and not have sport brand names or logos visible on them.

- Hair should be neat and smart at all times. Long hair must be tied back. Hairbands and hairclips should be neutral colours or navy blue and there should be no other hair accessories, for example bows. Only larger items such as scrunchies and plain Alice bands are acceptable in a dark blue colour.
- The school does not allow dyed hair or fashion hairstyles such as Mohicans or tramlines or where the hair is obviously of differing lengths.
- Only small silver or gold studs maybe worn. No hoops or fashion earrings. Children wearing anything but silver or gold studs will be asked to remove them. Earrings must be taped over for PE lessons
