


Reception News 02.11.18

Dear Parents and Carers



In Maths this week the children have been counting and adding one more. We have shown them the Maths symbols + and = and the children have tried very hard to write their own number sentences. We have been very impressed with how quickly the children have picked this concept up.

In Literacy we have been focusing on our phase two phonics. Lots of the children are blending their letter sounds well in order to read words and are remembering some of our tricky words too! The children have also become very confident in our group reading sessions during phonics where they are independently recognising lots of the words.



Next week:

- In Mathematics we will be beginning to learn about one less.
- In Literacy we will be thinking about rhyming words, using the book The Gruffalo.
- The <u>YELLOW</u> group will be doing 'Show and Tell' on Friday. The theme is still Fireworks.
