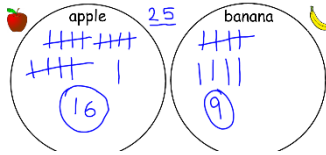

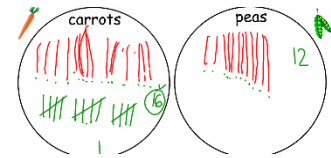

Dear Parents and Carers



We've had a busy week in Reception this week. In Maths we have enjoyed doing some Data Handling. We began the week by learning how to do a tally chart to record data. We discovered that in RF apples were

more popular than bananas and in RH carrots were more popular than peas. We then looked at other ways of recording data and made a class pictogram to find out the most popular pets.



In Literacy we have enjoyed listening to some of the other stories in the Funnybones collection. We have been discussing the job of the author and illustrator and have been thinking about the fact that all of the stories have the same main characters but different things are happening.

We've also enjoyed doing our PE this week. Both RF and RH came together to play some listening and instruction games. We enjoyed our session out on the KS1 playground and were impressed with the skills that the children demonstrated such as skipping, hopping and jogging.

- In Literacy we will be introducing the children to our new topic of 'minibeasts'.
- In phonics we will be recapping some of the Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.
