Dear Parents and Carers

We've had another busy week in Reception this week. We are so proud of all of them. They have coped tremendously well with the Reception routine. Well done Reception!

On Tuesday morning the children enjoyed their first computing session. They all walked sensibly to the Computer Suite and were very excited to have their own computer to log in to. The children then had a go at playing some games on Cbeebies and creating a picture on 2Paint.



In Phonics we've completed the next set of letter sounds g, o, c and k. The children are really enjoying our daily phonics sessions and are becoming more confident when participating with the activities. Well done Reception!

In Maths we have been exploring the concept of finding matching pairs. The children have been busy matching things by colour, shape and size. We have been impressed with how well the children have found pairs of socks, matching buttons and matching Autumnal objects.

In Literacy we have been reading lots of social stories about sharing fairly, building confidence and being kind. We are encouraging the children to try to remember to do all of these things when in school.

Home Learning:

- This week we would like to encourage you to have a go at matching the socks in your sock drawer. Maybe your child could help you pair up the socks once they've been washed. Don't forget to let us know how you get on via Tapestry.



Next week:

- In Maths we will be learning to recognise and understand the concept of the number one.
- In Literacy we will be introducing 'All About Me' bags (letter to follow).
- In phonics we will be continuing to learn the next set of our Phase 2 sounds.
- It will be **RED** groups turn to do Show and Tell. Our Show and Tell topic is My Family. We would love for the children to bring in a family photograph or a picture they have drawn of their family to share and talk about with their class.
