This week in nursery we have been talking about heavy and light. We looked at a picture of an elephant and a picture of a mouse and I asked the question which one they thought might be the heaviest and which one might be the lightest. We got lots of different objects to see which ones were the heaviest and which ones were the lightest. We had a game of buying some oranges from the shop and put one orange on one side of the scales and 1 orange on the other side of the scales. We talked about the scales balancing and that balancing means both fruits must weigh the same. During choosing time and small group time the children had the opportunity to explore weighing lots of different objects. Well done nursery!



The children enjoyed listening to the story 'Where oh where is Rosie's Chick?' We had lots of fun looking at the pictures to see where she was hiding. We looked inside her pen and under the hay and up the tree. The children came up with lots of ideas of their own.

We have continued to practise our number recognition and have played lots of different games. The children especially enjoyed playing a game of bingo. They waited patiently for their turn to lay their number/picture cards down and also helped one another. The children are getting really good at developing their fast recognition of 3 or 4 pictures and objects without having to count them individually. Fantastic work nursery!

On Tuesday morning we had our Forest School lesson. We walked to the big field and down into the woods. Mr Morris showed us all the little dens that the bigger children had made and then we had a game of hide and seek. The children were given some conkers and acorns to hide around the woods and then we all had lots of fun to see if we could find any of them. We then had some hot chocolate and walked back to nursery. We all had so much fun. Thnak you Mr Morris.
