Dear Parents and Carers,

This week in nursery we have been learning all about sequencing. We sang our days of the week song and then afterwards I asked questions such as what day was it yesterday and what day will it be tomorrow? We then talked about what they do when they wake up in the morning. During small group time the children had the opportunity to share their morning routine with their friends. Well done everyone!

The children were very excited to plant their cress seeds. I demonstrated how they needed to do this and encouraged the children to use language such as first, then, next and after. They first chose their pot and then they put the cotton wool inside the pot, next they put the cress seeds on top of the cotton wool and then after they gave the seeds some water. We are going to watch the cress grow and soon they will be bringing them home. Lovely work nursery!

During choosing time the children had the opportunity to complete a day and night cutting and sticking activity. This involved the children cutting out the little pictures and then placing them in the correct day or night scene. They really enjoyed this activity and I was very impressed how they completed this independently. Fantastic work nursery!

The children listened really well to our stories 'The Tiny Seed' and 'Contrary Mary'. 'Contrary Mary' is a story about a little mouse that woke up one morning and decided to do everything the wrong way just to be contrary. The children found this story really funny and we had lots of laughter. Well done nursery!

We have continued to practise our rhyming words and segmenting and blending simple CVC words. The children are really enjoying having a try at robot talk. I am very impressed with you all. Such clever children!



Outside the children have enjoyed playing in the sand, water and playing with the number skittles, hopscotch and looking for minibeasts in the soil using the magnifying glasses.



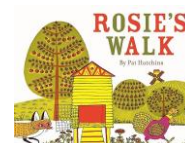
### Next week
