During our little group times we have been going over all the phonic sounds and the actions that we have learnt so far and we are all so pleased and proud of how many the children know. Amazing Children!

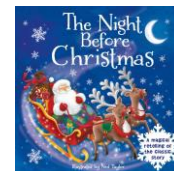
