

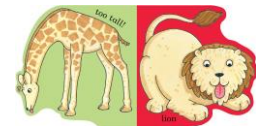


Robertswood Nursery News 17.01.20

Next Week

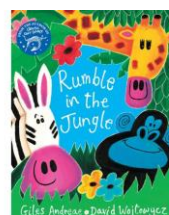
On Monday the children will be attending a drama workshop in the big school.
