This week our book of the week was 'Mr Gumpy's Outing'. The children listened well and later during our small group time they really enjoyed seeing if they could remember the order of the animals that went on Mr Gumpy's boat. We used the small world people and a boat to act out the story. We were very impressed with how many children remembered the order and the different language that Mr Gumpy used when he spoke to the children and the animals, for example, the children asked "may we come with you?", "yes, if you don't squabble." Excellent work nursery!

The children also enjoyed planting their cress seeds in a container, we have been checking them every day making sure they have enough water. They are very excited to take them home sometime next week. Well done nursery!

This week we have been talking about floating and sinking, we collected lots of different items to test in the water. We all had so much fun and next week we are going to be making some boats with different materials, and we will see if they float or sink when we take them outside to put them in the water.

We have continued to practise our sounds and the actions during our phonics, and this week we went outside to practise writing the sounds on the ground using the big chinks. Some of the children were able to draw a picture to match their sound card that they had chosen. Amazing work nursery!
